

The hotel rooms are on a first come, first serve basis. There are 24 rooms that have 1 queen bed and the possibility of getting a rollaway (they have a total of 15 twin size rollaway beds according to their information). They have two rooms that have a queen bed and one twin bed (rooms 201 & 203). The hotel rooms are charged in addition to the camp fee. Here is the hotel room info:

(Youth & children under age 19 are not allowed to stay in the hotel unless they are staying with a parent or guardian.)

Per room, per night	\$48.00
Rooms 201 & 203, per room per night	\$58.00
Rollaway beds, per room per night	\$10.00

So here is how it would look for camp fees and a hotel room for a husband and wife:

Fee - \$325.00

Hotel - \$240.00 (Rooms 201 & 203 \$290)

Total - \$565.00 (Rooms 201 & 203 \$615)

If there were 3 family members under the same camp fee the cost would be:

Fee - \$350.00

Hotel room - \$240.00

Rollaway bed - \$50.00

Total - \$640.00

If an additional person outside your family stayed in the same room with you his/her cost would be:

Fee - \$215.00

Rollaway - \$50.00

Total - \$265.00

If you opt to stay in the Cabins (cabins sleep 17, each cabin has 8 bunk beds and 1 twin bed) you would need to bring your own bedding, pillows and towels, etc. The cabins are air conditioned. The only cost for staying in the cabins is your camp fee.

Here is the info on linens in the hotel rooms:

Linens, pillows, blankets, towels and washcloths are provided and should be left inside the hotel at all times. Daily room service is NOT provided. (If staying more than one night, you will need to bring additional towels and wash cloths.) Also, you need to bring your own towels to take to the pool. Food and dishes from the Dining Hall are to be left in the Dining Hall.
