Dear Brethren,

Ozark Christian Camp invites you to Camp Paron June 25- 30, 2017. You can access a map on our website. The campground is located just north of Paron, Arkansas off of Arkansas Hwy 9. We welcome you to a week full of good teaching and great fellowship!

Campers will assemble with the River Street Church of Christ for our first service at 5:30 p.m. on Sunday evening, June 25. The church will be open from about 4:00 p.m. that afternoon to welcome all the visitors. Following the Sunday evening service, a meal will be served in the fellowship hall. After supper we will travel out to the campground to spend Sunday night.

Monday through Thursday we will follow the daily schedule that is available on the website. On Friday we will do final clean up and then break camp.

We have the use of several buildings for housing. These are dormitory type housing with bunk beds. You must provide your own towels, washcloths and bedding. We encourage you to pack individually since you may not always be housed together as a group. The cafeteria, assembly room and dorms are air-conditioned.

Recreation areas are available to all campers. However they may be reserved for special activities.

Prayer Garden

A new addition to the camp! It is a place for quiet reflection and meditation.

Activities Building

Ping pong tables & shuffle board are available. *(This building may be closed due to use as a meeting space.)*

Swimming Pool

No unauthorized or unsupervised swimming is allowed. The pool will be available during the summer months by reservation only.

Each group must furnish a RED CROSS CERTIFIED LIFEGUARD for each scheduled swim time.

Trading Post

Open for snacks between sessions and at free times. Hours of operation will be posted in the dining hall and lodging areas.

Geo-Caching Coordinates for the course are available from the Trading Post. Some GPS units are available for rent. *You must notify the Camp Manager **before** using the course.*

The deadline for registration is June 1st in order to receive a t-shirt. We encourage you to send in your registrations early this year and include your t-shirt size. We want to provide a t-shirt to all who register on time. Due to time constraints for making t-shirt orders, we cannot provide t-shirts for late registrations.

We ask that a parent or adult supervisor accompany children under 12 years old. **Young people age 18 and under who are not accompanied by a parent must sign the Parent/Guardian Agreement and Medical Release Form and return it with your Registration Form.**

Our dress code is knee-length shorts for the day sessions; if you wear anything shorter than knee-length, you may be asked by the camp directors to change into something more appropriate. Please do not bring gym shorts to wear; you need shorts that are knee length. You will also need a cover-up to wear between the swimming pool and the dorm.

You will want to bring some dress clothes for the evening services. We remind both girls and boys to dress modestly. We understand the difficulty that mothers and daughters sometimes have when shopping. Most fashions that are in stores do not meet the modesty standards that the camp wants to maintain. We do encourage the young ladies to find dresses that do not have spaghetti straps or that are strapless. If this is all you can find when shopping, then you can wear some kind of cover over the top. Please help us by complying with these guidelines, and we thank-you for your cooperation.

The theme for this year's camp is **Know God – Serve God, 1 Chronicles 28:9-10.** Brother Tom Bennett from Spearsville, LA will be our speaker in the evening services and will also teach public speaking. Brother Scott Gage from Fayetteville, AR will be music instructor. We are looking forward to a great camp. We encourage families to come to camp together as a family. It's an experience that your family will cherish in years to come.
