DIRECTIONS

Directions to River Street COC:
415 River Street, Benton, AR

Take the Sevier Street exit off I-30 in Benton, AR.
Follow the exit to South Street and go north to the stoplight.

Turn right (east) at the light onto Richard Street and go to the caution light.

At the caution light, turn left (north) on River Street.
The church will be on your left.

Directions to Camp Paron from River Street COC:

Head northeast on River Street toward Gunn Street.

Make a slight right at W. South Street

Take the 2nd left onto N. East Street

Make a slight left at E. Carpenter Street

Continue onto AR-5 N

Turn right on AR -9

Turn right onto Baptist Camp Road

Directions to Camp Paron from I-40

Take exit 108 (Morrilton)

Turn South on Highway 9

Turn left onto Baptist Camp Road

Camp Paron includes 263 acres of rolling hills and open grasslands adjacent to the Ouachita National Forest. Some recreational activities include: football, softball, kickball, horseshoes, basketball, four-square, tennis and volleyball courts, and a pool.
